

## Basingstoke East - Disneyland Paris 2023

### Payment Terms & Conditions – Phase 2 Registrations

This lays out the terms and conditions of the payments for the event. Phase 2 registrations is anyone that registers for the event between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 15<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

#### 1. Cost of event

The maximum amount payable to Basingstoke East Scouts for this event is £475 per participant. We are working to try and reduce this amount and if we are able to do so this will be reflected in the final payment.

#### 2. Deposit Payment

Will be payable within 7 days of registration

#### 3. Payment Plan

The remainder of the event is to be paid via direct debit directly to Basingstoke East Scouts in as the following payments. As mentioned in section 1 if the price can be reduced your final payment will reflect this\*.

You may also opt to pay in full.

#### 4. Refunds and Cancellations

As with most Scout activities we have a large amount of money to pay out to secure transport, accommodation, etc. Therefore we have to be very stringent around cancellations of the event.

- a. The deposit payment is non-refundable. Once paid this secures your place on the trip and we can not refund this payment under any circumstance.
- b. As each further payment installment is made it also becomes non-refundable. This is because we have to make payments to our suppliers at various points between now and the event.
- c. If you cancel attendance of the event you'll need to be paid up to date at the point of cancellation, however inline with 4.b no further payments will be due.
- d. If you opt to pay in full, your refund policy falls inline with the monthly payment plan, so the amount you would have paid on that will be non-refundable. This is broken down and shown on [bescouts.org.uk/Disney](https://www.bescouts.org.uk/Disney)

5. Coronavirus

Due to ongoing pandemic and the risk it poses to the trip we will be making decisions based on the current guidance from the UK and French governments. We will not be able to make a claim against cancellation of the trip due to a change in regulations but will have a certain flexibility up until 6 weeks before where we can make an informed decision.

6. Insurance

We hold an event level insurance policy but this does not cover individual cancellations. For example if you cancelled attendance due to being ill before departure, you would not be able to claim a refund on our event insurance and would also not be eligible based on section 4. We therefore strongly advise participants to have their own cancellation insurance in place. Some family annual policies will cover this, but you need to check the wording of such policies.
